## Call for applications Concert Projects for Young Audiences – Season 2017-18



#### **Application Deadline:**

#### May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016 (postmark or email date serve as proof)

Jeunesses Musicales Canada (JMC) invites Canadian musicians, to present interpretive or theatrical concert projects that will engage, inspire, and excite young students with the wonder of music.

Solo and duo concert projects, and projects including woodwind instruments are particularly sought.

#### **Details of Concert Projects**

The concert must be original, interactive, musically educational, and of the highest quality on every level. It may also include another component (theatre, dance, visual arts, etc.) to captivate the attention of children and enrich their understanding of the musical material being presented. Concerts are intended for school audiences (6 to 12 years old) or pre-school audiences (3 to 5 years old). The duration of concerts for school audiences must be 55 minutes, divided into approximately 35 minutes of music and a 20-minute interpretive segment; concerts for pre-schoolers must be between 35 and 40 minutes in duration. The concert may be presented in English or in French.

#### **Qualifications**

- Strong musical and/or artistic skills;
- Originality of the theme and concept;
- Feasibility of the project (1 to 4 musicians; light staging elements, which can be quickly and easily set up by the touring musicians themselves);
- High quality repertoire, ideally from the classical repertoire, mostly written for the instrument and suitable for the target audience;
- Comfortable speaking in public and communicating with children of 3 to 12 years of age;
- Autonomous and responsible (able to go on tour alone and to quickly find solutions to issues that may arise);
- Valid driver's license;
- Availability and flexible schedules allowing for day-time work, as well as the ability to tour.

#### Stages of evaluation

- 1. All applications will be reviewed by the selection committee. Candidates who are eliminated will be notified by mail.
- 2. Auditions for the selected candidates will take place before an artistic committee. For the audition, the musicians must present a fifteen-minute excerpt of their proposed concert.

Following the auditions, the musicians whose concerts best reflect the JMC's mission will then be invited to join the JMC programme directly in the next season or to rework certain aspects of their concert in order to eventually join the programme. Musicians whose concerts are not accepted may request comments and feedback from the artistic committee. On the basis of those comments, these musicians may submit a new proposal and eventually request a second audition.

#### **Application material**

All candidates must submit an application file, which includes:



The completed application form;

A synopsis of the young audiences concert including
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1. The title, a summary of the concept and a description of the concert development. (Indicate clearly the target audience: pre-schoolers or elementary school)

2. The list of the proposed musical repertoire, totalling about 35 minutes (or 60% of the length of the concert). The proposed repertoire must include pieces written for the instruments, not only transcriptions, arrangements or original compositions;

3. An excerpt of the script for the interpretive portion of the concert (examples of musicians' comments or characters' dialogue)

A demo mp3 or CD. If you wish, you can update your profile by sending a DVD or Youtube links of your project. However, the audio files are mandatory;

A press kit for the musician or ensemble (if available).

Note: - Incomplete documentation cannot be evaluated and will therefore not be considered.

- If you wish to eventually have your material returned to you, please clearly indicate so and include a selfaddressed envelope with sufficient return postage.
